By obtaining the MuseumCard, you can visit more than **350 museums and archaeological** sites affiliated with the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of the Republic of Turkey unlimitedly for a year.

WHEN VISITING NATURAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE SITES AS WELL AS SENSITIVE AREAS, PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING AND VISIT WITH CARE

- · Consideration of visiting hours,
- Appropriate dress code when visiting mosquesi,
- Wearing the slippers provided for visitors when entering mosques and disposing of them in the trash containers provided when leaving,
- Wearing a headscarf in sacred areas and placing the provided materials back in their places after use,
- Being considerate in areas where photography is not allowed,
- Avoiding entry into areas under restoration and excavation in archaeological sites,
- Avoiding interaction with children to protect their physical and mental integrity,
- · Being environmentally conscious,

- Not littering in natural conservation areas,
- Avoiding activities that harm animals and plants in their natural habitats,
- Being cautious when using fire or similar substances in forested areas,
- Adhering to behavioural rules when visiting historical and religious sites, not touching historical artifacts, and not damaging historical structures,
- The Gediz Delta, which is a Bird Sanctuary under the Ramsar Convention, is a protected area. All behaviors that could harm the birds should be avoided, and the environment should not be damaged.
